

PATIENT INFORMATION SHEET FOR THE COLLECTION OF FAECES (STOOL) SPECIMENS FOR OCCULT BLOOD

PREPARATION FOR THE TEST:

- 1. Specimens should not be collected during or within three days of menstrual period or if the patient suffers from bleeding hemorrhoids or blood in the urine.
- 2. Alcohol, aspirin and other medications taken in excess may cause gastrointestinal irritation resulting in occult bleeding. Such substances should be discontinued at least 48 hours prior testing.
- 3. No dietary restrictions are necessary before using the FOB One Step Faecal Occult Blood Test Device (Faces).

METHOD OF COLLECTION:

- 1. You are given three brown lid, white plastic jars/containers.
- 2. Collect one stool sample each on three days (use one jar/container for each collection).
- 3. Pass the faeces into a clean plastic container and using the scoop located on the lid of the brown top jar/ container, transfer a small portion of faeces into a brown-top jar/container.
- 4. Place the lid on the jar/container and tighten the lid firmly to prevent leakage. The patient is to discard the remainder of the sample into the toilet.
- 5. Label the jar/ container with your name, date of birth, date and time of collection. Deliver to the nearest Medlab Collection Centre or to your Doctors surgery for transport arrangements.
